




Powerful Sermon Series and Lay Training Seminars

Getting Decisions and Making Appeals





Uplifting Christ in the Doctrines

Families can have a loving, supportive, and healthy atmosphere in their homes. None of us are perfect. We all have faults and weaknesses. But everyone has the ability to learn how to be a loving husband, wife, father, and mother. David and Marquita will transparently share important life principles for families. This is best used at a family retreat or family ministries weekend. It can also be adapted for a men's or women's retreat.

God, I Don't Want to do This Anymore



This session is specifically for pastors and wives at workers meetings. Being a pastor can be lonely and discouraging at times. Though both a sacred and rewarding calling, there are moments when we fight discouragement and depression and find ourselves questioning our call. The reasons are many-- burnout, a difficult church, a verbally abusive member, conflict in the church or at home-- all these can destroy our passion for ministry. In this seminar, we use the story of Elijah running away from Jezebel to illustrate the pastor's struggles. I share my own personal struggle of being in the pit of discouragement and how God delivered me and restored my passion. We can also add topics such as: What Every Pastor's Wife Should Know, What Every Pastor's Wife Wants Her Husband to Know, What Every Pastor Wants His Wife to Know, What Every Pastor's Kid Wants His/Her Parents to Know.
